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#### **Pre-Conference Training Opportunities**

##### **Option 1: Purchase Card Training**

Mandatory training for any county seeking application for the State Issued credit card through OMES (Office of Management and Enterprise Services). This 3 hour training will also qualify for the mandatory CEU training for keeping the credit card in good standing.

##### **Option 2: Legislative Process**

The Legislative Process provides a thorough discussion of how a law is enacted in the Oklahoma Legislature. One component of the class is a current or former Representative or Senator presenting the “real world” legislative process. The class uses the internet to maneuver through the Legislative website to track bills through the legislative process, so bring your smart phone, laptop computer, or tablet with you if possible.
